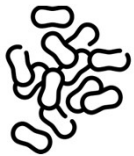


Ordinance Development

- LA County Ordinance Framework
- Commission, CBOs, Businesses and Ad-Hoc's.
- Minimal cost increase for businesses
- 1 to 2 years implementation date



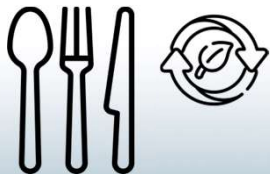
- Food facilities cannot distribute **single-use articles** that are neither compostable nor recyclable



- Retail establishments cannot sell **expanded polystyrene products**
- **Flexibility for certain food applications w/o options for compliant products**



- Third-party online food ordering businesses must allow food facilities to indicate which single-use foodware accessories they offer for customer selection



- Full-service restaurants must provide multiservice utensils instead of single-use articles to dine-in customers



Implementation Timeline

Category 2	1.5 years – September 18, 2025	<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Mobile food facilities (i.e., food trucks)
Category 3	2 years – March 18, 2026	<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Temporary food facilities○ Farmers markets○ Catering operations



Implementation

- Follow up workshop and reminders
- Compliant product resource
- Early Adopter Program - \$500 value
- Provide technical assistance on supplies
- Allow businesses to transition their inventory
